**ARCHITECTURAL STANDARDS BULLETIN  
RELATED TO MAIL BOXES**

The intent of this Architectural Standards Bulletin is to clarify and supplement Article IX, Section 9.17 of the Third Amended and Restated Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions.

Under Article IX, Section 9.17 of the Third Amended and Restated Declaration, all mail boxes must be affixed to posts made of wood or brick of the same type as used on the dwelling; and all mail boxes and supporting posts shall be of a design approved in writing by the Architectural Control Committee. In furtherance of the expressed intent of this restriction, and for purposes of clarity, molded plastic mail boxes affixed to a post of the same material, either as a single unit or in combination thereof and including a molded plastic mail box mounted on a supporting post of a different material shall not be allowed. Cast concrete mailboxes or those of similar appearance are expressly prohibited. Mailboxes shall not be mounted upon a metal post unless approved in writing by the Architectural Control Committee as a variance. The use of wrought iron mailboxes shall be acceptable.
